## 1-2-3-5 Beanie

**Materials:** about 50g Schachenmayr nomotta "Extra Merino"

1 set of five US #4/3.5 mm double-point needles

1 Tapestry needle

Size: The hat is very stretchy and will fit most teens and adults.


Gauge in basic pattern (slightly streched): 26 stitches/ 31 rows = 10 cm/ 4 inches


basic pattern: p1, k2, p3, k5

**CO** 110 sts distribute on four needles and join for working in the round. (If you want to finish each repeat with a needle then distribute the stitches 33 - 22 - 33 - 22, otherwise distribute 28 - 27 - 28 - 27 or whatever you like.)

Knit basic pattern for 48 rounds. (That makes about 6 1/4"/16 cm height unstretched.)

**Crown:** mark stitch 11, stitch 22, stitch 33, stitch 44, stitch 55, stitch 66, stitch 77, stitch 88, stitch 99 and stitch 110.





Round 49: slip 1<sup>st</sup> stitch on the fourth needle as if to purl, yarn remains behind the stitch. Knit or purl stitches as they appear. Work SKP on each marked stitch. (Slip marked stitch knitwise, knit one, pass slipped stitch over.)
Round 50: Knit or purl stitches as they appear.

Repeat twice (Round 51 – Round 54).

Rounds 55 - 59: Work as described for round 49.

Round 60: slip 1<sup>st</sup> stitch on the last needle as if to purl, yarn remains behind the stitch. Knit or purl stitches as they appear. Work . work *SK2P* on each marked stitch (Slip marked stitch knitwise, knit two stitches together, pass slipped stitch over.)

Break yarn, draw through remaining 11 sts, pull tight.

Weave in ends.
