"Socks" for Clogs

(by marion nowak/nowaks nähkästchen)

My wooden clogs scrub the back of my feet. Those light "footlings" help against that.

Materials: ca. 5g "Silvia" by Wetterhoff. (Or another fine non fuzy lace yarn with wool.)

2 circular needles US #00/ 1,75 mm (If you prefer you can use one circ and knit with the "Magic Loop" technique or knit with a set of dpns.)
1 Tapestry needle

Gauge in stockinette: 14 stitches = 5

Size: foot circumference about 26cm. (The footlings should be knitted with some minus width, so they will sit close on the foot.)

Co 60 stitches and close to round.

Cuff: 10 Rounds in 2-2 ribbing.

Main Body: k40 (on needle 1, those stitches will be on top of the foot later), 10 x (k,p) (on needle 2, those stitches will be unter the sole later.)



The following rounds the pattern will be worked over the 40 stitches of needle 1, on needle 2 you continue the 1-1 ribbing.

Pattern:

Rd 1: k2, 3 x (yo, k2tog, k3, yo, k, yo, k3, skp, yo, k1), k2.

Rd 2: k40, 10 x (k, p).

Rd 3: k2, 3 x (k, yo, k4tog, yo, k3, yo, k4tog tbl, yo, k2), k2.

Rd 4: same as Rd 2.

Rd 5: k2, 3 x (k, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, k2tog tbl, k2), k2.

Rd 6: same as Rd 2.

Rd 7: k2, 3 x (k2tog, yo, k7, yo,

k2tog tbl, k), k2.

Rd 8: same as Rd 2.

Rd 9: k, k2tog, 2x (yo, k9, yo,

slip1, kt2tog, psso), yo, k9, yo,

k2tog, k2.

Rd 10: same as Rd 2.

Rd 11 - 20: as Rd 1 - 10. Rd 21 – 24: as Rd 1-4.

Rd 22: k40, 5 x (k2, p2)

Cuff: 0 Rounds in 2-2 ribbing.

Bind off loosely.

Finish: Weave in thread ends and block lightly (over a glass) so the lace pattern will turn out better.
